# TWO LOCAL STUDENTS COMPETE AT THE JIMMY AWARDS IN NEW YORK CITY

Two local students made their Broadway debut on June 26! Hope Galloway from Brighton and Evan Williams from Le Roy represented Rochester, New York at the 2023 National High School Musical Theatre Awards (NHSMTA), also known as the <u>Jimmy Awards®</u>. They were chosen to compete in New York City following the local competition "<u>Stars of Tomorrow NYC Bound</u>," at RBTL's Auditorium Theatre in May.



Their journey to the Jimmy Awards began when they arrived in New York City on June 18 and a busy week followed. Hope and Evan were among 96 student performers from across the country competing at the Jimmys. Their first full day in the city included meeting their peers and watching welcome messages from industry professionals and Jimmy's alum/Tony Award® nominee Eva Noblezada. They also participated in a live taping of <a href="mailto:The Broadway League's">The Broadway League's</a> "Black to Broadway" podcast.

Throughout the week the students were immersed in vocal coaching sessions, choreography and musical rehearsals learning the ins and outs of Broadway from

industry professionals. Sometimes they were even joined by special guests including choreographers from "MJ The Musical" and Broadway stars Ben Platt ("Dear Evan Hansen," "The Book of Mormon," "Parade") and Noah Galvin ("Dear Evan Hansen," "Waitress")!


They also had the opportunity to see two Broadway shows, "Some Like it Hot" and "MJ The Musical." And a trip to New York City wouldn't be complete without eating at one of the city's most iconic restaurants, Sardi's. Finally, they ventured into Times Square and saw their own headshots on a billboard!

The week concluded on Monday, June 26 with the I4th Annual Jimmy Awards showcase at the Minskoff Theatre, home to Disney's "The Lion King." Hope and Evan both performed in the opening number, as well as in small group performances.

#### ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL SEASON OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING

Throughout each Season, RBTL offers a variety of educational programing. Here is a look back at some of the highlights from this past Season.

In December, RBTL launched its newest education program, Broadway Boost. The program, a four-day intensive, is led by three teaching artists, all with various areas of expertise in theatre. It's designed to connect national and area professionals with local high school and college students and focuses on themes of a touring Broadway show and, of course, the main areas of live theatre: singing, dancing and acting. It can also include a masterclass with cast members. Those who take part also get the chance to see the show the program is based around. The first Broadway Boost centered on "Come From Away,"



followed by ones for "Beetlejuice" and "SIX." Stay tuned for the 2023-2024 Broadway Boost program announcements!

The 2022-2023 <u>A.R.T.S. Partners</u> program followed the theme "Stories Matter: Finding power, hope and legacy in the path you take." It began with teachers integrating topics from "Hamilton," which had a special two-week engagement at RBTL's Auditorium Theatre in November, into their curriculum. The program then continued with "Come From Away," "Hadestown," "Aladdin," and "SIX," and concluded with "To Kill a Mockingbird." Included in the lessons was applying the students' own interpretations of the themes of the shows to original artwork. Some of their pieces were then displayed in the second-floor lobby of the Auditorium Theatre during each production's engagement.



Also, as part of the program, students at Dr. Charles T. Lunsford School No. 19 in Rochester and Gates-Chili Central School District had the chance to meet some of the cast of "Aladdin" and participate in a Q&A session with them. Among the cast members who visited the students were Marcus M. Martin ("Genie"), Jake Letts ("Babkak"), Taylor Mackenzie Smith (ensemble), Adi Roy ("Aladdin"), Senzel Ahmady ("Jasmine") and Aaron Choi ("lago").





They also had the chance to visit the theatre and see the touring Broadway production they had just learned about. For the 2023-2024 Broadway Season, A.R.T.S.
