SENATOR COONEY DELIVERS \$1 MILLION IN FUNDING FOR RBTL

Earlier this month, New York State Senator Jeremy Cooney announced \$1,000,000 in state capital funds he secured for the Rochester Broadway Theatre League. Senator Cooney explained that the grant is funding the renovation of the Joseph A. Floreano Room located at the West Herr Performing Arts Center. It's the only stream of funding helping to make this room's restoration a reality.

"RBTL and the historic West Herr Performing Arts Center brings world class performances directly to the heart of our city, serving as a cornerstone of what makes our community so special," said Senator Cooney. "This substantial investment is proof of our continued commitment to the arts outside of NYC and creating the kind of theatre that Rochesterians can enjoy for years to come."

"As has proven to be the case so many times in our community, Senator Cooney is the first to listen, the fastest to act and always fights hard to bring money to worthwhile projects," said RBTL CEO and Chairman of the Board of Directors, Arnie Rothschild. "State leadership does great work behind the scenes, but today, I am glad that what Senator Cooney is doing to make this restoration a reality is taking center stage."

Restorations will include a new pre-show concessions and gathering area, work to the detailed drywall and ceiling, flooring, new paint and more cosmetic upgrades. Combined with a new rear drop-off entrance, the new Floreano Room will be central for the accessible route for patrons with disabilities. The room is named after Joseph Floreano, longtime Executive Director of the Rochester Riverside Convention Center and former board member of RBTL.

RBTL is incredibly grateful to Senator Cooney for securing this significant funding and helping to progress PROJECT RESTOURATION! It's funding like this, along with community support, that is essential to realizing the vision of a beautifully restored cultural landmark.




The goal is to have this work done by the fall.




Straight No Chaser - Holiday Road Tour: December 3




Evaluators will meet at least one of the following requirements:

- A degree in a relevant field (music, theatre, dance, etc.).
- And/or extensive work experience in one of those disciplines on a professional or academic basis.
- And/or are professional artists or educators with knowledge of the American musical theatre canon.
- And/or demonstrate experience in or knowledge of musical theatre.

Additionally, all candidates:

- Must possess the ability to effectively communicate in writing.
- Must possess the ability to evaluate production elements and student performances in a constructive manner, maintaining an overall positive tone.
- Must be trained in the Stars of Tomorrow evaluation process by RBTL.
- Have the ability to recognize potential bias/conflicts of interest and to recuse oneself from those productions/students.
 - No judge will be assigned to a school with which there may be a conflict of interest, either through a connection to the school or to anyone associated with the production.
- Have the ability to evaluate fairly.
- Have the ability to maintain confidentiality.
- Have enthusiasm for high school musical theatre.
